A non-refundable application fee of \$75.00 (first application) or \$25 (additional applications) is required to be paid either by check or money order in U.S. dollars, payable to Oklahoma State University. Applications will not be processed until this fee is received. You can choose to submit your application and fee using the web based application. Send the following records to the Graduate College: 1. Official Transcripts/marksheets from all colleges and universities attended; 2. Certificate of official degrees completed; 3. TOEFL/IELTS scores*. All of these documents must be on file in the Graduate College before an application is considered "complete." Only complete applications are evaluated. A financial guarantee is required prior to the issuance of an I-20 for persons entering OSU on either an F1 or J1 visa.

Return this application, the appropriate application fee, and the requested materials to one of the OSU Graduate Admissions offices listed above.

Application Deadline: If you live in the United States, a complete application must be submitted at least 30 days prior to the departmental deadline or 30 days prior to the beginning of school (which ever is first). If you live outside of the United States, our deadline is March 1 (fall admissions) or August 1 (spring admissions). We will consider applications completed after these dates, but we cannot guarantee an admissions decision will be made in time to receive an I20 for the visa interview.

***TOEFL/IELTS Score:** Applicants for whom English is a second language are required to demonstrate an acceptable level of spoken English usually by submitting a TOEFL or IELTS score. A TOEFL score of at least 79 (internet based test), 213 (computer based test) or 550 (paper based test) is required regardless of the number of semesters or terms completed in other institutions of higher education, including OSU, or prior enrollment in English language programs. Alternatively, an official IELTS, academic stream, examination with a minimum overall band score of 6.5 will satisfy the English proficiency requirements for admission to a graduate program. Note that an applicant who has or will have completed a baccalaureate or graduate degree from a college or university where English is the primary teaching language, and which is located in a country where English is a primary language, is **not** required to submit a TOEFL or IELTS score.
