## 13. Test Scores

**English Proficiency Requirements** - an applicant who has graduated with a degree from an accredited institution of higher learning (or will have graduated by the start of their degree program at OSU) where English is the primary language of instruction, located in a country in which English is a recognized primary language is **not required** to submit a TOEFL or IELTS score.

Applicants for whom English is a second language are required to demonstrate an acceptable level of spoken English usually by submitting a TOEFL or IELTS score. Either examination must have been taken within the last two years.

A TOEFL score of 79 (internet based test), 213 (computer based test) or 550 (paper based test) or above is required regardless of the number of semesters or terms completed in other institutions of higher education, including OSU, or prior enrollment in English language programs. When requesting **ETS** to send official TOEFL scores reports to Oklahoma State University, please use the ETS institution code **6546** for OSU.

Alternatively, an official IELTS, academic stream, examination with a minimum overall band score of 6.5 will satisfy the English proficiency requirements for admission to a graduate program. When requesting **IELTS** to send official score reports to Oklahoma State University, please use the address appropriate to your requested major at OSU. Addresses are listed on page four of this application.

**Other Admission Test Scores** - Each program determines its own admission requirements, and some include the submission of a test score such as GRE, GMAT, or MAT as part of those requirements. Prospective students should contact the program if they have a question about if an admissions test is required prior to investing in the cost of the test.
